## **Submission Guidelines for Energy Summit 2023 for Abstracts:**

- 1. **Originality:** Submitted abstracts should present original and unpublished work. Plagiarism or self-plagiarism is permitted (less than 20%).
- 2. Formatting: Guidelines for Abstract Submission (Overall word limit: 350-500 words)

Major Objectives/Scope of Research: Please list the objective and/or scope of the proposed paper.

Methodology/Procedures: In short, describe the overall methodology, procedure and the way research was carried out.

**Results, Findings and Conclusion:** Briefly describe the results, major findings, and conclusions of the proposed paper.

**Novelty of research:** Describe the contribution of this article in adding novel information to the existing body of literature that will enhance the knowledge of the scientific community.

The abstract should follow the specified formatting guidelines. Use a clear and concise writing style, and include the essential elements of your research, such as the objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions.

- 3. Length: The length of the abstract should adhere to the specified word limit (350-500 words). Ensure that you provide sufficient information to convey the key points of your study.
- 4. Language: Abstracts must be written in English. Make sure your abstract is grammatically correct and well-written.
- 5. **Submission Process:** All abstracts should be submitted through the designated online submission system provided on the conference website. Follow the instructions carefully and provide all necessary details, including author names, affiliations, and contact information.
- 6. **Review Process:** Submitted abstracts will undergo a review process by conference expert committee in the field. The review may consider factors such as relevance, scientific merit, clarity, and significance of the research.
